

St Vincent de Paul Food Drive for the month of April will be moved to the weekend of 12th & 13th.

My son, you are here with me always;
everything I have is yours.
But now we must celebrate and rejoice,
because your brother was dead and has come to life again;
he was lost and has been found."
- Luke 15: 31-32

This weekend we come to the Fourth Sunday of Lent, a Sunday which is traditionally called Laetare Sunday. The Latin word "Laetare" means "rejoice", and today's Gospel describes the reason for our joy in the midst of this solemn Lenten season. The source of our our joy today is found in this weekend's Gospel: God's great love for us that has been revealed in Jesus. Through his Passion, Death, and Resurrection, Christ has reconciled us with God and one another.

Our Gospel from Luke narrates the third of three parables that Jesus taught in response to his criticism by the religious leaders of the day that he associated and dined with sinners. These three familiar parables—the lost sheep, the lost coin, and today's parable of the prodigal son—invite us to consider the depth of God's mercy and love. Although this parable is often called the Parable of the Prodigal Son, I love to refer to it as the Parable of the Loving, Forgiving Father. We can always find great consolation that no matter what we do, no matter how many times we do not live as the children God created us to be, God is always running toward us with open arms. We find that great love and mercy of our Heavenly Father in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. In this beautiful sacrament, we can, like the younger son, return to our Father when unfaithful and say "Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you" knowing that our Father will respond with love, mercy and joy. We must not miss the opportunity this Lenten season to restore our relationship with the Father and one another through great gift of the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

May we rejoice this day in our Heavenly Father's great love and mercy for us, Deacon George


