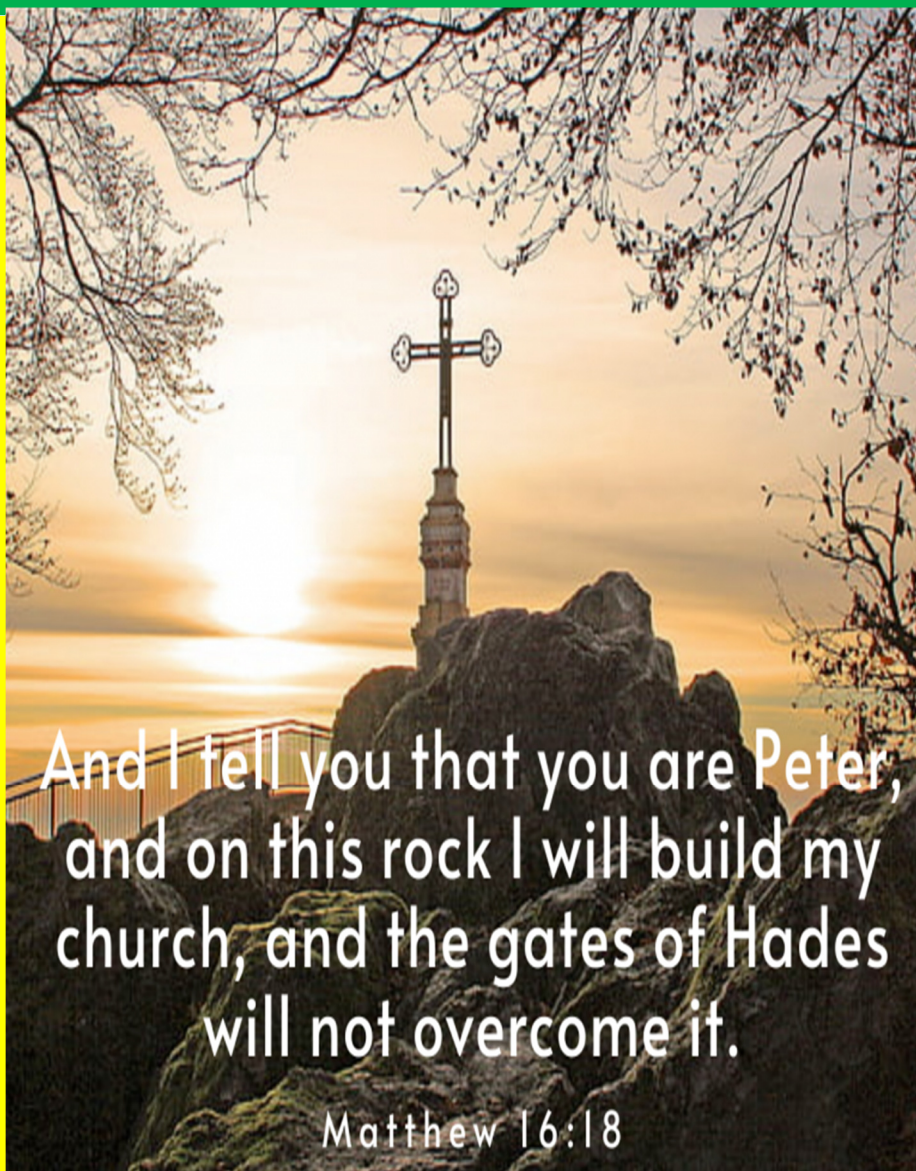

Pondering With Deacon George:

"Who do you say that I am?"

In our Gospel passage today, Jesus asks His disciples a deeply personal question: "Who do you say that I am?" While many people had opinions about Jesus, Peter responds with faith: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

This question is not only for Peter. It is directed to each of us as well. In a world filled with many voices and competing values, Jesus invites us to move beyond what others say about Him and to answer from our own hearts. Our relationship with Christ cannot be based solely on tradition, family, or public opinion. It must become a personal encounter and conviction.

Peter's confession was possible because God revealed the truth to him. Faith is not merely the result of human reasoning; it is a gift that opens our eyes to recognize Jesus as our Savior. Yet we well know that Peter was not perfect. He would later fail and deny Jesus. This reminds us that God chooses imperfect people and entrusts them with great responsibility.

Jesus then gives Peter the keys of the Kingdom, symbolizing authority and service within the Church. This reflects Christ's desire to build a community founded on faith, unity, and mission. The Church continues to stand on this foundation, despite human weaknesses, because Christ Himself remains its true cornerstone.

This week in our prayer we can ask ourselves:

Who is Jesus to me today?

Do my words and actions show that I truly believe He is the Son of God?

How can I strengthen my faith and witness more courageously to others?

May we, like Peter, always recognize Jesus as the Christ, the Son of the living God and live that belief by our lives,

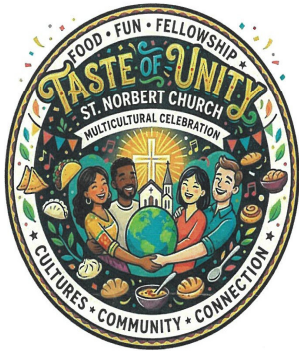

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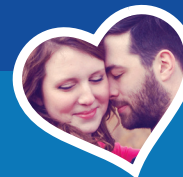
